We will be holding a free eye exam.
The test will take place on Monday, October 16th and Tuesday, 17th. Please fill out the yellow permission card and return it. If your child does not attend either of these days please use the sign-up sheet next to the cubbies to sign-up your child.

We hope all our preschool families will take advantage of this opportunity. Each year since we have been holding the eye screening there have been at least two children who have had very limited vision in one or both of their eyes. Parents have said in the past that their children have had eye exams with their family doctor, so did these children. The greatest moment was when one little boy received his glasses and remarked that trees have leaves.

Again, this is a free eye exam and we encourage all parents to take advantage of it.



SHOW-&-TELL

"Children's Teaching Time"

Why do we have "Show-and-Tell"? When children are encouraged to bring things from home, they begin to understand that each one of them is a "teacher" with something to help others learn. As they share something of themselves with others, they gain confidence in becoming the focus of the group's attention. They practice speaking skills, they find out that others are interested in them, they discover there are things they know about, they feel good about themselves, and they feel good about doing it. We need to discourage children from bringing weapons, war toys, action figures and trinkets from fast-food restaurants. "What's left"?

Here are some suggestions:

- *Something found in nature such as; wildflowers, acorns, seeds, driftwood, shells, and pinecones.
- *A living thing like; a worm, pet bird, tadpoles, a caterpillar, a vegetable plants, or a house plant.
- *Exotic or little-known food items (perhaps that the children could tastes).
- *A safe tool such as; an eggbeater, an orange squeezer, a garlic press, a hand drill, a fountain pen, or a pencil sharpener. A tool is anything used by hand to cause something to happen.
- *A photo from a newspaper, a magazine, a book or a snapshot. Items children have made themselves such as; drawings, paintings, clay sculptures, collages, homemade hats, or other craft items.
- *Items with an unusual texture, smell, or taste.
- *An item that is "scientific" (magnifying glass) or "historical" (postcard of an old for or places you have visited).

We hope this will help you with what to bring for Show-and-Tell. IF possible please have it start with the "Letter of the Week" found on the calendar or in the Dew Drops.

*This year your child will have one day per week to bring in Show-and-Tell. Please check the Show-and-Tell schedule. The same schedule will be used for the entire year. Thank you!
