

Plan for Re-Starting In-Person worship during green phase

We plan to have one service at 9:00am in the Summer Sanctuary and will also be live streamed to Facebook and posted to YouTube. Please know that the YouTube video may not be available until Monday or Tuesday.

Just for fun, since we are move into the green phase, please consider wearing green that day!

Things to know if you're planning to come to worship (9:00am):

- Everyone attending worship will need to wear a well-fitting mask.
 - While we would encourage you to bring your own, disposable masks will be on hand for anyone who needs one.
 - The Pastor and Organist will maintain safe distances and remove their masks while speaking, so that the Pastor's words are not muffled or while the organist is playing the piano or organ.
 - Soloists will be allowed to remove their masks long enough to sing (again, keeping a safe distance (up to 16 ft.) to make up for the absence of a mask
- We anticipate that there will not be restrictions on number of worshipers, but we will be practicing social distancing. Please do not move chairs from the location they were placed. There will be chairs for families of 2, 3 or 4 members.
- To help with the cleaning and disinfecting of the church, please use the doors at the kitchen to enter the building. All other doors will be locked and no entrance will be granted through any other doors. These doors will be propped open till the service begins or someone will be there to open them for you to avoid touching of handles.
- Bulletins will be emailed to members of the church by the Friday prior to worship. Please feel free to use your tablet or phone to download a copy if you prefer. Printed copies will also be placed on each chair for guests or those without access to the internet. Rest assured that we will make sure that everyone can join in!
- All personal items as well as the paper bulletins must be taken home with you and not left behind.
- We will not be using hymnals, Bibles or Order of Service books.
- Congregational singing is not possible during this time as the act of singing increases the amount of air leaving our lungs and, in turn, increases the risk of spreading virus. The Organist will arrange for special music from time to time. The Pastor and Organist will continue to work together to choose appropriate music for each service.
- Children are definitely welcome, but will have to stay with their families. There will be a children's message each week but we ask that children stay seated with their parents.
- We will not be passing offering plates or communion elements. Instead, there will be a basket as you enter/leave to collect an offering. The next bullet describes communion.
- When we have communion we will distribute individual Communion packs with the elements for everyone. There will not be any open elements distributed. All elements will be received in a sealed container.
- Windows will be open and the fans will be running throughout the service to provide maximum airflow.
- Bathrooms will be available. We will have extra precautions in place such as conveniently placed

paper towels and trash cans so that you don't have to touch handles/faucets with bare hands. Sanitizer will also be located outside of each bathroom so that you can have an added layer of protection.

- At the conclusion of the service everyone is asked not to return into the hallway but rather to exit through the doors located at the far end of the social hall that exits directly into the parking lot. There will not be a receiving line with the Pastor, we encourage worshipers to exit the building immediately following the service.
